Tasks may include:

- Apply: Blankets, Burlap, Curing Compounds, or Water for Concrete Curing and Protection.
- Used Hand/Special Tools: Edgers, Floats - Fresno - Screeds (Hand or Vibratory) - Tamp - Trowels (Hand or Machine) - Concrete Saw Machines (Hand or Walk-Behind) - Curb & Gutter Machines - Power Buggy - Pump/Slickline - Mucked
- Obtain Grades - Use Transit or Laser - Site Preparation
- Place, Level, Finish Concrete (includes Curb & Gutter, Valley Gutter, Barrier Rail, Median Curbs, Steps, Pervious Concrete, Flat work [to include all types of finishes])
- Set Screed Pins - Moved Screed Bars - Set Forms - Site Layout

- Use Pounders or Imparted Stamp Design Into Cementitious Materials
- Broadcast Colored Chips, Glass, Metal, or Sand
- Level Concrete or Stamp Mixture
- Mix Stamp Mix/Products
